

SHDWID WATER CONSERVATION LEVELS - A Conservation and Drought Response Plan

Conservation Level	Course of Action	Triggers
Level 1	Maintain only efficient and wise use of water	Normal - above normal water precipitation or Groundwater levels 90% or better of previous year's March level or storage capacity maintainable 90% or better
Level II In Addition to Level I Actions	Reduce normal water consumption by 10-20% Reduce outdoor watering No hosing down of driveways or decks	1-20% below normal winter precipitation or Groundwater level 80% or better of previous year's March level or storage capacity maintainable 80% or better
Level III In Addition to Level II Actions	Reduce normal water consumption by 20-30% Outside watering once every 3 days	21-50% below normal winter precipitation or Groundwater levels 70% or better of previous year's March level or storage capacity maintainable
Level IV In Addition to Level III Actions	Reduce normal water consumption by 40%+ No outdoor water use Limit indoor water use	51%+ below normal water precipitation or Groundwater levels 50% or less than previous year's March level or storage capacity maintainable 60% or less
